

The Shamar Prophet

Hosea 12:13

By a prophet the Lord brought Israel out of Egypt, And by a prophet he was preserved.

Number 14: 11

11 Then the Lord said to Moses: “How long will these people reject[d] Me? And how long will they not believe Me, with all the [e]signs which I have performed among them?

12 I will strike them with the pestilence and disinherit them, and I will make of you a nation greater and mightier than they.”

13 And Moses said to the Lord: “Then the Egyptians will hear it, for by Your might You brought these people up from among them,

14 and they will tell it to the inhabitants of this land. They have heard that You, Lord, are among these people; that You, Lord, are seen face to face and Your cloud stands above them, and You go before them in a pillar of cloud by day and in a pillar of fire by night.

15 Now if You kill these people as one man, then the nations which have heard of Your fame will speak, saying,

16 ‘Because the Lord was not able to bring this people to the land which He swore to give them, therefore He killed them in the wilderness.’

17 And now, I pray, let the power of my Lord be great, just as You have spoken, saying,

18 ‘The Lord is longsuffering and abundant in mercy, forgiving iniquity and transgression; but He by no means clears the guilty, visiting the iniquity of the fathers on the children to the third and fourth generation.’

19 Pardon the iniquity of this people, I pray, according to the greatness of Your mercy, just as You have forgiven this people, from Egypt even until now.”

20 Then the Lord said: “I have pardoned, according to your word;

21 but truly, as I live, all the earth shall be filled with the glory of the Lord—

22 because all these men who have seen My glory and the signs which I did in Egypt and in the wilderness, and have put Me to the test now these ten times, and have not heeded My voice,

23 they certainly shall not see the land of which I [f]swore to their fathers, nor shall any of those who rejected Me see it.

24 But My servant Caleb, because he has a different spirit in him and has followed Me fully, I will bring into the land where he went, and his descendants shall inherit it.

Moses was an awesome Prophet and I will bring the Ministry of the Shamar Prophet front and center in this lesson.

Hosea speaking of Moses tells how God used Moses to bring Israel out of Egypt, Moses walking in the office of a Prophet functioned in prophetic intercession. Moses literally stood between life and death for Israel.

The Shamar prophet cannot be overlooked by the church in this end time hour. The word Shamar emphasizes the protective element of the prophet's mantle.

This Pastor will never operate this Church again without the Mantle of the Shamar Prophet. The Shamar Prophet is guardian of the church, guardian of the ministry, and guardians of the Pastors.

A Shamar Prophet's roll is extensive; his role will have Prophetic Intercession, Prophetic discernment, Prophetic praise, prophetic preaching, prophetic teaching, and Prophetic worship. It's the job of the church to recognize the Shamar Prophets of a church, and to train them.

A Shamar Prophet is a watchman. Shamar means to guard, to protect, to be a watchman. A Shamar prophet is a gatekeeper. A church does not need one but many Prophets. Shamar Prophets have it in their hearts to be the protectors of the Pastors, Pastors, Protectors of his family, and of the church. The Shamar prophets of this church are the Prophetic Guards.

The Shamar Prophet is a guardian of the flock. God makes us care for the flock. The Shamar Prophet will be a wall the enemy has to get through to get to the flock. He will encircle his flock. His nature is to be a hedge around the church. The Shamar Prophet is a gate builder. A repairer of the breaches.
